MANUSCRIPT GUIDELINES/COMMENTS:

Topics Include. The Academy of Finance invites submission of new scholarly empirical or theoretical papers in all areas of Finance including but not limited to Corporate Finance; Financial Institutions; International Finance; Portfolio & Security Analysis; Real Estate and Insurance & Risk Premium.

The papers presented at the Academy of Finance may be published in the *Journal of the Academy of Finance*. Four copies of the manuscript under a separate cover page containing the manuscript title, the name, position, and institutional affiliation of each author must be mailed to the editor. The body of the manuscript should contain no identification of author(s). All manuscripts are evaluated anonymously by at least two reviewers. The manuscript must not have been published previously or submitted elsewhere while under review by the *JAF*.

Submissions must be postmarked between January 1st and March 30th. Any submissions mailed after March 30th of a year will not be considered for publication in the journal edition of that year. Those papers will be returned to the authors with a recommendation to resubmit between January 1st and March 30th of the following year.

Submitters may be invited to participate in the review process and may be asked to present their papers at the annual meeting of the Academy of Finance. The Academy of Finance's national conference has traditionally been held in Chicago, over a three-day period, between the last week in February and last week of March. Only articles presented at the annual meeting will be considered for inclusion in the journal, which is published in Summer and Fall of every year. Authors of accepted submissions will be asked to submit a camera-ready copy of their manuscript and an electronic copy, using Microsoft Word. Address manuscript and correspondence concerning *JAF* to the editor, and observe the following specific guidelines in manuscript preparation.

1. **Margins.** Margins for the first page of manuscript should be 1½" from top, 1½" from bottom and 1" from left and 1" from right of the page. The margins for all other pages must be same as for the first page with the top and bottom margins reduced to 1" only.
2. **Author(s) Name(s) and Paper Title.** Please use author(s) name, paper title, affiliation, telephone, and email only on the cover sheet. Author(s) name or the paper title should not appear anywhere in the body of the paper. The first page of the paper should start with literature review or abstract (NO TITLE PLEASE) and then the main body of the paper. Indent paragraphs and a spacing between each paragraph.
3. **Publication Fee and Page Numbers.** Authors of all accepted papers will not pay any fee for 1-10 pages. \$15 per page fee for pages 11-15 and \$100 per page for any page over 15. Please note that \$150 publication fee will be charged if all co-authors did not register in the Academy of Finance. Page numbers should be at bottom center of the page. And, all pages must be numbered 1 through n.
4. **Table and Bibliography.** All tables must be numbered in roman numerals and placed just before the bibliography. Place references in the paper inside parentheses, e.g., (Fama 1999; Balik 2004). Explanatory footnotes are discouraged, but necessary footnotes should be numbered and placed at the bottom of the page on which they appear. Bibliography containing all references should appear at the end of the paper.
